Booking and payments

Pitches may **be booked online** (www.omniqstore.eu/camperparkingwervik) or at the **kiosk at the campervan site entrance**.

Payment is **by bank card only**. The fee includes the use of electricity, the discharge of domestic wastewater and the emptying of chemical toilets.

Fresh water can be replenished by inserting the correct amount of € 1 coins into the dispenser (it does not give change). The charge is shown at the kiosk. If you do not have enough or the right coins, just stop by at the nearby De Balokken cafeteria or the Tourist office (a short walk away).

No need to worry if you forget to bring along a **water** hose to draw off **drinking** water at the sanitary station, you can loan one from the Tourist Office on payment of a € 20 deposit.

<u>Automatic access control with number plate recognition</u> (ANPR)

The **unattended** campervan site is equipped with an automatic access system. Upon arrival, you should drive up to the barrier. If you have booked in advance (online), the barrier will open automatically. If you are booking a pitch onsite, please move your vehicle for a short while so that the camera can detect your number plate. Your vehicle's number plates is also scanned when you leave, after which the barrier opens automatically.

Please note that on arrival, you will not be able to enter the campervan site until 11h AM.

You are free to driven in an out during the booked stay period.

What to do in case of technical failure

Do not hesitate to let us know about any problems you encounter when entering or leaving the site or if certain site facilitates are not operating as they should.

Cycling

Hiking

- De Balokken recreational island: large natural area (36 ha). The park entrance is on the other side of the campervan site.
- Wervik Wervicq-Sud urban hiking trail (5 km): explore the unknown yet rich past of our city, one of the oldest in Belgium! Start at the National Tobacco Museum/Tourist Office (Koestraat 63) – follow the bronze rivets.
